









Legendary Personalities Appreciated the Worth and Work of Syed Fakhruddin Balley











Profile He took part in Muslim leaders gathering of 1906 in Dhaka as an envoy of province Syed Fakhruddin Balley Agra.



Heart Disease: Syed Fakhruddin Balley had a heart attack in 1980. Doctors had recommended him to quit smoking and take rest. But he did none of them. He lived 24 years with heart problem. He left his work for children's happiness and then started his working again with lot more passion. Doctors said that only one forth part of his heart is working.





Last Days of Life: In the last period of his life, he had to put oxygen pipes in nostrils for 18 hours but this disease could not let him down. We had not seen such will power and self-confidence before. He had moved to Nishtar hospital in second week of January 2004. He thanked God in severe health condition. He had thanksgiving nature.
